12-6-2003 Priority setting

1. Contribute to EU environmental policies: 19 issues, 46 p
2. Set up relevant EFAEP services: 11 issues, 35 p
3. Promote the environmental profession: 10 issues, 25 p
4. Improve EFAEP operations: 9 issues, 19 p

The General Assembly decides to focus on 1, 2 and 4

Priority 1: Contribute to EU environmental policies

1. Four working groups have started:

- Policy and strategy
- Information and education
- Waste
- industry

2. Get the 4 working groups operational (2003 activity).

Outputs (in 2003): 4 working groups operational, 4 action plans ready and approved

2. Get every working group to organise at least one international seminar in 2004 and 2005 on a relevant issue (evaluation ex post or ex ante of an EU environmental directive).

Outputs in 2004: 2 international seminars organised and 1 advice given to the EU Commissioner of the Environment

Priority 2: Set up of EFAEP services

1. Set up of a database of environmental professionals and experts. **Outputs:** a pool of responsible persons, an operational database
2. Set up of a system for international job opportunities and for the international exchange of students and traineeships . **Outputs:** a pool of responsible persons, a working system.
3. Set up a system for systematic provision of a periodic up-date of EU legislation and what is in the pipeline. **Outputs:** a pool of responsible persons, a working system

Priority 4: Improve EFAEP operations

1. Prepare a longer term business plan. **Output:** an approved 2005-2008 business plan
2. Generate substantial subsidies. **Goals:** raise a minimum of 100.000 € yearly from 2005, make this structural
3. Get more member associations. **Output:** at least one member association from every European country
