- Overviews of key EU statements for ENEP members from European Commission including State of the Union, Annual Policy Strategy and work programme (due out in November each year).
- Setting up Brussels programmes including high level external speakers at general assemblies and working groups.
- Organising ENEPs presence at European Green Week and OPEN DAYS 2011
