- Not all good volunteers will work without cost refunds
- GA attendance is less than perfect
- ExCo members cannot give more of their time
- Many good plans & ideas shipwreck on lack of funding

This is not a work plan

But we know what we want:

- Better/more services to our members
- A more influential role in EU policy making and implementation
- Much more intensive, fruitful exchanges of knowledge, information and experience
- And possibly many other things:
 - Job mediation services
 - A professional certification scheme
 - Internship exchange services
 - Detailed, tailored EC regulatory information...

Paths towards Funding

- d. Provide paid services
